What will the children do in the Road To Foundation program?

The program consists of weekly sessions, led by our experienced Early Years teachers. In these sessions, the children participate in a variety of activities, including craft, fine motor skills, oral language, computing, early numeracy, pre-reading, social skills and pre-writing.

When does the Road to Foundation Program take place?

This year, the Road To Foundation Program will take place in **Term 4**. The program consists of weekly sessions, led by one of our teachers. Each session is held from **9:15:10:15am every Tuesday morning, beginning 18th October. The last Road To Foundation day will be November 15th. After this our transition program will begin.**

How will the Road To Foundation program benefit my child?

Participation in the Road To Foundation program will assist your child as they make the transition to school.

The program will:

- Ease children into an unfamiliar environment, making it a familiar and friendly place.
- Enable children to get to know their new classmates, school surrounds and school routines.
- Introduce children to some of the teachers, classrooms, toilets, playground areas and office.
- Boost children's confidence and make them feel comfortable about starting school.
- Foster a positive attitude towards school.
- Ease separation from parents.
