PARKING & TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Next Wednesday 13th September, Bendigo Councillors and COGB transportation staff will be at our school to observe traffic flow and parking at the end of the school day. For those members of our school community who undertake the daily pick up, you will understand the difficulties that can be had at this time of day. I hope the meeting and observations will assist in developing a plan to better support parking and traffic flow at our school.

SCHOOL ARRIVAL TIME

Students continue to arrive at school prior to 8:30am, however the school yard is NOT supervised before this time. If your child seeks to leave home early please remind them they should not be at school before 8.30am.

If a situation arises where your child needs to be dropped off early (for example parent work commitments) please contact the school and ask for information in relation to our Before School Care program. Our Before School Care program operates 5 days a week and opens at 7:00am. The only exception to this is Tuesday and Thursday when we run our breakfast program. On these days, students can arrive at 8:15am to enjoy breakfast with other students. At 8:45am classrooms open for students to prepare for the start of the school day.
