Financial Support for Families

PAYMENT PLANS

If at any time parents are having problems in paying for extra-curricular items and activities, we offer a payment plan. Please do not hesitate in talking to us and it will be explained how it operates. Additionally, at any time during the year families are invited to make small, regular/irregular contributions to family accounts for extra-curricular activities or curriculum contributions.

EFT

CENTREPAY

We have Centrepay set up at the school so if you receive payments from Centrelink you may wish to use this facility. Please contact the office and we can explain how it works.

Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF)

If you hold a current Centrelink health care card, pension card etc and the student is listed on this card, you will be eligible for the CSEF which can be used for camps, sports & excursions. It is \$150 per primary student per year. Please contact the office if you have not already applied.

CAMPS & EXCURSIONS

All camps & excursions must be **paid in full** before the event occurs as per School Policy.

Arrangements for payment

All families will be given sufficient time to make payments for camps and excursions. Parents will be provided with permission forms and excursion information clearly stating payment finalisation dates. Alternative payment arrangements can be organised with the Principal or Business Manager.
